

Dear Crystal Beach Tennis & Yacht Club Renters:

Welcome to our community and we hope you enjoy your stay with us.

Please take a moment to review some of the rules below as well as information regarding recycling. If you have any questions, feel free to ask our On-Site Manager or Security.

- CBTYC quiet hours are from 11:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. No loud noises on CBTYC property is permitted after 11:00 p.m. This includes the beach, clubhouse and other common areas.
- Hanging towels, swimsuits or other clothing on front or side railings of homes is strictly prohibited.
- Tents are not permitted on CBTYC property.
- Parking is permitted only in the driveway or curbside fronting the home you are staying at. **Do not park in front of other homes.** Guest parking is also permitted in the guest overflow parking spaces by the Clubhouse/Pool. No parking is permitted at either cul-de-sac on Promenade Way – these are fire lanes.
- Renters or guests can not bring gem cars or golf carts into CBTYC. If a cart is provided with your rental, operators must have a valid driver's license. It is impermissible for children to operate these vehicles at any time, including on the lap of a licensed driver.
- Gas powered scooters are prohibited.
- Dogs belonging to renters and their guests must be on leashes when outside. Dogs are not permitted on the beach between 10 am and 6 pm.
- **No glass bottles or containers are allowed on the beach or in the pool area.**
- **No fires on the beach.**
- Food is prohibited inside the pool area.
- There is to be no loud yelling or use of profane language in the pool area.
- No rafts or flotation devices allowed in the pool area at any time. However swim aids or water wings are acceptable.
- No radios or stereos are allowed unless used with a headset.
- Swimmers are permitted to use the main floor restrooms (after drying off) and must enter through the front door of the Clubhouse and walk directly to the restrooms. No wet bathing suits on furniture.
- Access to the Clubhouse Exercise Room and Pier is forbidden.

RECYCLING

Recycle appropriate household materials in the designated containers in the trash area. In order for the recyclables to be picked up and processed, they must be in the appropriate receptacles. **Please read and abide by the instructions that appear on the signage behind the recycling bins.**
